Abraham - The Father of the Faithful

Romans 4:7-11

I. Abraham, A Great Bible Character...

- •Greatness of Abraham seen from a number of standpoints:
 - -Frequency of mentions...
 - •(Abram) Gen. 11:26-17:5 \rightarrow , 61 times in 50 verses
 - Abraham \rightarrow 250 times in 230 verses, including 74 times in 70 verses in the New Testament.
 - —He was the man chosen by God to be the father of the nation through whom the Savior would come, the recipient of the promises. (Gen. 12:1-7; 22:18)
- •So many great events in the life of Abraham:
 - -Leaves his home as instructed by God. (Gen. 12:1); Gives Lot the land choice. (Gen. 13:8)
 - -Rescues Lot from the warring kings. (Gen. 14:1-16); Blessed by Melchizedek. (Gen. 14:18ff)
 - -Sodom and Gomorrah. (Gen. 18:23 ff); Offering of Isaac. (Gen. 22)
 - -Abraham in the New Testament...Matt. 1:1; Lk. 16:25; Gal. 3:26-25

II. The Faith of Abraham

- Abraham's faith was based on God's revelation.
 - —God revealed himself to Abraham:
 - •In Ur of the Chaldees. (Acts 7:2-4; Gen. 15:7); At Haran of Mesopotamia. (Gen. 12:1-4)
 - •At Shechem in Canaan. (Gen. 12:6-7); After Lot went to Sodom. (Gen. 13:14-17)
 - •Many more times. (Gen. 15:1-17; 17:1-27; 18:1-33; 22:1-19)
 - -Our faith must be based on revelation:
 - •Rom. 1:18ff; Ps. 19:1-6
 - •I Cor. 2:9ff; Rom. 10:17 → faith comes by hearing and hearing by the word of God.
 - •John 20:30-31 → it contains the evidence that we might believe.
 - •If we are to have the faith of Abraham, we must receive God's revelation.

•Abraham's faith was in the promises of God: (Rom. 4:20)

- Three great promises made to Abraham. (Gen. 12:1-7; 22:18)
 - •Nation. (Ex. 19:6)
 - •Land. (Josh. 21:43; 23:14)
 - •Seed. (Acts 3:25-26)
- -God has made great promises to us today: (II Pet. 1:3)
 - •Forgiveness. (Acts 2:38)
 - •Blessings. (Matt. 6:33; Eph. 1:3)
 - •Heaven for the faithful. (Titus 1:2)
 - If we are to have the faith of Abraham, we must embrace the promises of God.

Abraham had faith in the power of God: (Heb. 11:19)

- -Gen. 17:1 → I am the Almighty God...
 - •Abraham had faith in the power of God to bring Isaac into the world. (Rom. 4:19-20)
 - •Abraham had faith in the power of God to raise the dead. (Heb. 11:19)
 - •Abraham had faith in the power of God to destroy. (Gen. 18:23)
 - •Abraham had faith in the power of God that went beyond this present life. (Heb. 11:10,14)
- -We must have faith in the power of God:
 - •To give spiritual life. (Eph. 1:19ff; 2:1; Rom. 1:16; Jn. 3:1-5); To destroy. (Matt. 10:28)
 - •To raise the dead. (I Cor. 15:20); To save the faithful eternally in heaven. (I Thess. 4:17)

• Abraham's faith was an obedient faith. (Gen. 22:18; 18:19)

- -Abraham obeyed God's commands:
 - •Leave your home. (Gen. 12); Sacrifice your son. (Gen. 22); Js. 2:20-24
- -We must obey the commands of God today: Rom. 1:5; 16:26; Rom. 6:17-18; II Thess. 1:7-9; Matt. 7:21
