
Abortion, The Bible, and The Case For Life

Prov. 6:16-19

The Case For Life - The Argument

- It is wrong to intentionally kill an innocent human being.
- Abortion is the intentional killing of an innocent human being.
- Abortion is wrong. It is sinful, it is evil, it is morally reprehensible.



The Developing Human: Clinically Oriented Embryology: "A zygote is the beginning of a new human being (i.e., an embryo). Human development begins at fertilization, the process ... to form a single cell called a zygote. This highly specialized, totipotent cell marks the beginning of each of us as a unique individual."

Human Embryology & Teratology: "Although life is a continuous process, fertilization is an important landmark because, under ordinary circumstances, a new, genetically distinct human organism is thereby formed... - Dr. Alfred M. Bongioanni, professor of pediatrics and obstetrics at the University of Pennsylvania, stated:
 - "I have learned from my earliest medical education that human life begins at the time of conception.... I submit that human life is present throughout this entire sequence from conception to adulthood and that any interruption at any point throughout this time constitutes a termination of human life....I am no more prepared to say that these early stages [of development in the womb] represent an incomplete human being than I would be to say that the child prior to the dramatic effects of puberty...is not a human being. This is human life at every stage."

- Dr. Jerome LeJeune

 professor of genetics at the University of Descartes in Paris, was the discoverer of the chromosome pattern of Down syndrome.
 - "after fertilization has taken place a new human being has come into being." He stated that this "is no longer a matter of taste or opinion," and "not a metaphysical contention, it is plain experimental evidence." He added, "Each individual has a very neat beginning, at conception."

- Professor Hymie Gordon, Mayo Clinic:
 - "By all the criteria of modern molecular biology, <u>life is present from the moment of conception."</u>
- Professor Micheline Matthews-Roth, Harvard University Medical School:
 - "It is incorrect to say that biological data cannot be decisive.... It is scientifically correct to say that an individual human life begins at conception.... Our laws, one function of which is to help preserve the lives of our people, should be based on accurate scientific data."
- Dr. Watson A. Bowes, University of Colorado Medical School:
 - "The beginning of a single human life is from a biological point of view a simple and straightforward matter—the beginning is conception. <u>This straightforward biological fact should not be</u> <u>distorted to serve sociological, political, or economic goals."</u>

 Summary: "Scientifically, your life as a human being began at conception. You are the same human being that you were when you were 6 years old, though you look very different. You are the same human being you were at 6 months in your mother's womb. The same human being you were as a 6 - day - old embryo. You've matured in size, awareness, independence, and other ways. But you started out human, and you will end human." (Scott Klusendorf)

- The case for life and against abortion is ultimately rooted in the Creator who is the Giver of life; and found in His revealed will, the Bible.
 - Act 17:26-29 → And hath made of one blood all nations of men for to dwell on all the face of the earth, and hath determined the times before appointed, and the bounds of their habitation; 27 That they should seek the Lord, if haply they might feel after him, and find him, though he be not far from every one of us: 28 For in him we live, and move, and have our being; as certain also of your own poets have said, For we are also his offspring. 29 Forasmuch then as we are the offspring of God
