Acts 8:32-35

Of Whom Speaketh The Prophet This? (Acts 8:34)

- **Gen. 3:14-15** → And the LORD God said unto the serpent... 15 And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between **thy seed** and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel. (**Gal. 4:4; Heb. 2:14-15**)
- **Gen. 22:18** → And in **thy seed** shall all the nations of the earth be blessed; because thou hast obeyed my voice. (**Acts 3:25-26; Gal. 3:16**)

Of Whom Speaketh The Prophet This? (Acts 8:34)

- *Isa. 53:4-9* → ... he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth. 8 He was taken from prison and from judgment: and who shall declare his generation? for he was cut off out of the land of the living: for the transgression of my people was he stricken. 9 And he made his grave with the wicked, and with the rich in his death; because he had done no violence, neither was any deceit in his mouth. **(Acts 8:32-35)**
- **Jesus Is The Answer. (1 Pet. 1:10-12; 2:24)**

Who Shall Deliver Me From The Body of This Death? (Rom. 7:24)

- All have sinned and come short of the glory of God. (*Rom. 1:32; 2:1-3; 3:9,23*)
- The wages of sin is death. (*Rom. 6:23*)
 - God's holiness and justice demands a penalty for sin. (*Hab. 1:13; Prov. 6:16-19*)
 - God in his mercy wants to save the sinner. (*II Pet. 3:9; Ezek. 18:23*)
 - The question: How could God manifest justice and still extend mercy to the sinner?
- *Jesus Is The Answer. (Rom. 3:23-26; 5:1; 6:3-4; 8:1)*

Romans 3:20-28

Romans 3:20-28 → ...**all the world may become guilty before God.** 20 Therefore by the deeds of the law there shall no flesh be justified in his sight: for by the law [is] the knowledge of sin. 21 **But now the righteousness of God without the law is manifested, being witnessed by the law and the prophets;** 22 Even the righteousness of God [which is] by faith of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all them that believe: for there is no difference: 23 **For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;** 24 Being **justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus:** 25 Whom God hath set forth [to be] a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God; 26 To declare, [I say], at this time his righteousness: that he might be just, and the justifier of him which believeth in Jesus. 27 Where [is] boasting then? It is excluded. By what law? of works? Nay: but by the law of faith. 28 **Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith without the deeds of the law.**

Who Will Never Leave Or Forsake Us In The Difficulties of Life?

- Each one faces trials, temptations, hardships, sorrows, loss and disappointments. (**Job. 14:1; II Tim. 3:12**)
- Consider Paul. (**II Cor. 4:8-11; 18; II Cor. 11:23-33; 12:5-10; Phil. 1:12,18, 21; 4:11-13; II Tim. 4:16-17**)
- ***Jesus Is The Answer. (Heb. 2:14-18; 4:15-16; 13:5-6)***
 - The provisions He has made for us:
 - ✦ Acts 20:32 → The word of God
 - ✦ Eph. 6:10ff → The armor of God
 - ✦ I Cor. 10:13 → Escape in time of temptation
 - ✦ I Pet. 5:7 → He cares for you
 - ✦ I Pet. 3:12 → His ears are open to our prayers

Conclusion...

- Who provides the hope of resurrection and eternal life?
 - **Jn. 6:68 → Jesus has the words of eternal life...**
- Whom must we obey to be saved?
 - **Jesus is the author of eternal salvation to all who obey him. (Heb. 5:8-9)**
- To whose church do the saved belong?
 - **Jesus built his church. He is the savior of the body. (Matt. 16:18; Eph. 5:23)**
- In whose name must one be baptized for the remission of sins?
 - **Repent and be baptized everyone of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins. (Acts 2:38)**
