# What Does This Mean?

Deut. 6:20-25

#### Exodus 12:25-27

- 25 And it shall come to pass, when ye be come to the land which the LORD will give you, according as he hath promised, that ye shall keep this service.
- 26 And it shall come to pass, when your children shall say unto you, <u>What mean ye by this service</u>?
- 27 That ye shall say, It *is* the sacrifice of the LORD'S passover, who passed over the houses of the children of Israel in Egypt, when he smote the Egyptians, and delivered our houses. And the people bowed the head and worshipped.

## Deuteronomy 6:20-25

- 20 "When your son asks you in time to come, 'What is the meaning of the testimonies and the statutes and the rules that the LORD our God has commanded you?'
- 21 then you shall say to your son, 'We were Pharaoh's slaves in Egypt. And the LORD brought us out of Egypt with a mighty hand.
- 22 And the LORD showed signs and wonders, great and grievous, against Egypt and against Pharaoh and all his household, before our eyes.
- 23 And he brought us out from there, that he might bring us in and give us the land that he swore to give to our fathers.
- 24 And the LORD commanded us to do all these statutes, to fear the LORD our God, for our good always, that he might preserve us alive, as we are this day.
- 25 And it will be righteousness for us, if we are careful to do all this commandment before the LORD our God, as he has commanded us.'

### Joshua 4:6-7; 21-24

- 6 that this may be a sign among you. When your children ask in time to come, <u>'What do</u> those stones mean to you?'
- 7 then you shall tell them that the waters of the Jordan were cut off before the ark of the covenant of the LORD. When it passed over the Jordan, the waters of the Jordan were cut off. So these stones shall be to the people of Israel a memorial forever."

## Joshua 4:6-7; 21-24

- 21 And he said to the people of Israel, "When your children ask their fathers in times to come, <u>'What do</u> <u>these stones mean?'</u>
- 22 then you shall let your children know, 'Israel passed over this Jordan on dry ground.'
- 23 For the LORD your God dried up the waters of the Jordan for you until you passed over, as the LORD your God did to the Red Sea, which he dried up for us until we passed over,
- 24 so that all the peoples of the earth may know that the hand of the LORD is mighty, that you may fear the LORD your God forever."

### Matt. 9:10-13

- 10 And as Jesus reclined at table in the house, behold, many tax collectors and sinners came and were reclining with Jesus and his disciples.
- 11 And when the Pharisees saw this, they said to his disciples, "Why does your teacher eat with tax collectors and sinners?"
- 12 But when he heard it, he said, "Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick.
- 13 <u>Go and learn what this means</u>: 'I desire mercy, and not sacrifice.' For I came not to call the righteous, but sinners."

## Acts 2:12, 16

- 12 And all were amazed and perplexed, saying to one another, <u>"What does this mean?"</u>
- 16 But this is that which was spoken by the prophet Joel.
- 21 And it shall come to pass, *that* whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved.
- 38 Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.
