## Isaiah 59:1-5

Behold, the Lord's hand is not shortened, That it cannot save; Nor His ear heavy, That it cannot hear. <sup>2</sup> But your iniquities have separated you from your God; And your sins have hidden His face from you, So that He will not hear. <sup>3</sup> For your hands are defiled with blood, And your fingers with iniquity; Your lips have spoken lies, Your tongue has muttered perversity. <sup>4</sup>No one calls for justice, Nor does *any* plead for truth. They trust in empty words and speak lies; they conceive evil and bring forth iniquity. <sup>5</sup> They hatch vipers' eggs and weave the spider's web; He who eats of their eggs dies, And from that which is crushed a viper breaks out.

<u>Galatians 6:10</u> - "Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all, especially to those who are of the household of faith."

3. Violation/Breaking of God's Law
1 Jn. 3:4 – Whoever commits sin commits lawlessness

There is law and if we break it, we sin

- a. Eph. 4:25 Do not lie
- b. Heb. 10:25 Do not forsake
  - Assembly
  - Acts 2:38

d. 2 Tim. 2:2

Repent and be Baptized
Teach others so they can, in turn teach others

2. Sin is a personal refusal to be governed by God

3. Sin is a failure to keep God's commands

4. Sin is Iniquity (perverse)toward God

5. Sin is a transgression (rebellion) against God

## What are we to do about Sin?

Recognize it Must know Gods Word to recognize it Confess it We must admit we have a problem with it Repent of it We must remove it from our heart Flee From it Stay far away from it – the closer we get, failure is likely

## What are we to do about Sin?

Warn others of the consequences of it We must Evangelize

Help each other overcome it

- We must discuss it with brethren and support each other
- Withdraw from those who continue in it
  - We must have a change in relationship

The one who says "I have come to know Him" and DOES NOT keep His commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in Him; but whoever **KEEPS** His word, in Him the Love of God has **TRULY** be perfected. By this we KNOW that we are IN HIM."

- Chosen generation, royal priesthood, His own special people (9)
- Abstain from fleshly lust (11)
- Honorable conduct before others & do good works (12)
- This is will of God & will silence ignorance of fools
