Four Great Commands In The Great Commission

Matt. 28:18-20

The Great Commission

And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth. *Go* ye therefore, and *teach* all nations, *baptizing them* in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: *Teaching them* to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, Io, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen. (Matt. 28:18-20)

Go

- Mark 16:15-16 → 15 And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. 16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.
- Acts 1:8 → "... ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth."
- Acts 8:4 → Therefore *they that were scattered abroad went every where preaching the word.*
- Acts 15:35 → Paul also and Barnabas continued in Antioch, teaching and preaching the word of the Lord, with many others also.
- Phil. 1:12-13 → 12 But I would ye should understand, brethren, that the things which happened unto me have fallen out rather unto the furtherance of the gospel; 13 So that my bonds *in Christ are manifest in all the palace*, and in all other places;

Teach (Make Disciples)

- John 6:44-45 → 44 No man can come to me, except the Father which hath sent me draw him: and I will raise him up at the last day. 45 It is written in the prophets, And they shall be all taught of God. Every man therefore that hath heard, and hath learned of the Father, cometh unto me.
- Rom. 10:17 → So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.
- Acts 8:35 → Then Philip *opened his mouth,* and began at the same scripture, and *preached unto him Jesus*.
- Acts 9:6 → And he trembling and astonished said, Lord, what wilt thou have me to do? And the Lord said unto him, Arise, and go into the city, and *it shall be told thee what thou must do*.

Teach (Make Disciples)

- Acts 10:6,22,33 → 6 He lodgeth with one Simon a tanner, whose house is by the sea side: *he shall tell thee what thou oughtest to do*. 22 And they said, Cornelius...was warned from God by an holy angel *to send for thee into his house, and to hear words of thee*. 33 Immediately therefore I sent to thee; and thou hast well done that thou art come. Now therefore are *we all here present before God, to hear all things that are commanded thee of God.*
- Acts 11:14 → Who shall tell thee words, whereby thou and all thy house shall be saved.
- Acts 16:13-14 → And on the sabbath we went out of the city by a river side, where prayer was wont to be made; and we sat down, and *spake* unto the women which resorted thither. 14 And a certain woman named Lydia, a seller of purple, of the city of Thyatira, which worshipped God, *heard* us: *whose heart the Lord opened*, that she attended unto the things which were spoken of Paul.

Teach (Make Disciples)

- 1Pe 3:15 → 15 But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and be ready always to give an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the hope that is in you with meekness and fear:
- 2Ti 2:2 → And the things that thou hast heard of me among many witnesses, the same commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also.
- Phil. 2:15-16 → 15 That ye may be blameless and harmless, the sons of God, without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom ye *shine as lights in the world;* 16 Holding forth the word of life; that I may rejoice in the day of Christ, that I have not run in vain, neither labored in vain.

Baptize

- Mar 16:16 → He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.
- Act 22:16 → And now why tarriest thou? arise, and be baptized, and wash away thy sins, calling on the name of the Lord.
- Rom 6:3-4 → 3 Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death? 4
 Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like
 as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father,
 even so we also should walk in newness of life.
- 1Co 12:13 → For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body, whether [we be] Jews or Gentiles, whether [we be] bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit.
- Eph 4:5 → One Lord, one faith, *one baptism*

Baptize

- Gal 3:26-27 → 26 For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus. 27 For as many of you as have been *baptized into Christ have put on Christ.*
- 1Pe 3:21 → The like figure whereunto even *baptism doth also now save us* (not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God,) by the resurrection of Jesus Christ:
- Act 2:38 → Then Peter said unto them, *Repent, and be baptized* every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.
- Act 8:36 → 36 And as they went on their way, they came unto a certain water: and the eunuch said, See, here is water; what doth hinder me to be baptized?

TEACH

Eph 4:11-16 \rightarrow 11 And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; 12 For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ: 13 Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ: 14 That we henceforth be no more children, tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive; 15 But speaking the truth in love, *may grow up into him in all things*, which is the head, even Christ: 16 From whom the whole body fitly joined together and compacted by that which every joint supplieth, according to the effectual working in the measure of every part, maketh increase of the body unto the edifying of itself in *love.* (cf. Matt. 13:21; Acts 14:21-22; Jude 20)
