### I. A Stark Study In Contrast

## o <u>Nicodemus</u>

- Mis name was Nicodemus. (3:1)

### The Samaritan Woman

- She was a woman. (4:9,27)
- She was a rank sinner. (4:16-17)
- We don't know her name.

## o Nicodemus

- ➣ He was a member of the Sanhedrin. (3:1; 7:50; 19:39-42)
- ∞ He was a Jew. (3:10)
- Me had great interest in talking to Jesus.

### o <u>The Samaritan Woman</u>

- She was a woman of no worldly distinction.
- She was a Samaritan. (4:7,9)
- She did not come to Jesus. (4:6)
- so She had no apparent interest.

### Nicodemus

- Desus taught Nicodemus the necessity of the new birth. (3:3-5)
- 50 The reaction of Nicodemus: How?
  - Me struggles with the concept.

  - ∞ Cf. 7:50; 19:39

### The Samaritan Woman

- 50 The response of the Samaritan woman: Give me this water. (Jn. 4:15)
  - ∞ A prophet. (4:19)
