Lessons From Bible Baptisms

Eph. 4:1-6

I. The Baptism Unto Moses (I Cor. 10:1-2)

- •The account. (Ex. 14)
 - -In the cloud and in the sea. (I Cor. 10:2; Ex. 13:21-22; 14:29)
 - -Necessary for their salvation. (Ex. 14:30-31)
 - -They were identified with Moses identified as his disciples. (I Cor. 1:13; Gal. 3:26-27)
 - —Their baptism delivered them from bondage and began their journey to the land of promise.
 - -Their arrival in Canaan was not guaranteed. (I Cor. 10:1-13)

II. Jesus' Baptism Of Suffering (Matt. 20:22; Lk. 12:50)

- •The immersion of injury, pain, suffering and death that Jesus endured for you and me.
 - —Isa. 53:1-12 → stricken, smitten, afflicted, wounded, bruised, stripes, oppressed, cut off, an offering for sin.
 - —Matt. 26:39 \rightarrow "O my Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me; nevertheless, not as I will, but as thou wilt."
 - -Heb. 5:7-8.

III. <u>The Baptism of John (Matt. 3:1-11)</u>

- •Things to note about John's baptism:
 - -Repentance required; kingdom at hand
 - —Fruit manifested repentance.
 - —In the Jordan, confessing their sins. (Jn. 3:23)
 - -Baptism of repentance for the remission of sins. (Mk. 1:4)
 - -Superseded. (Acts 19:3-6)

IV. The Baptism of Jesus (Matt. 3:13-17)

- John recognizes Jesus as the Son of God. (Jn. 1:33-34)
- •To fulfill all righteousness. (Matt. 3:15) → to fulfill every righteous requirement.
- •We must fully fulfill every requirement of God. (Jn. 14:15; Rev. 22:14)

V. The Baptism of The Holy Spirit (Matt. 3:11)

- Only two recorded cases in history:
 - —The apostles on the Day of Pentecost. (Acts 2; cf. 1:5)
 - —Cornelius and his household. (Acts 10:44;11:15-16)
 - For the purpose of revealing and confirming God's word. (Heb. 2:1-4)
 - Fulfilled: all truth has been revealed and confirmed. (Jn. 16:13; II Pet. 1:3)

VI. Baptism In The Name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit (Matt. 28:20)

- •This is the one baptism that is in force and necessary for the salvation of sinners today. (Eph. 4:5)
 - -Mk. 16:16; Acts 2:38; Acts 22:16; Rom. 6:3-4; Gal. 3:26-27; I Pet. 3:21

VII. The Baptism of Fire (Matt. 3:11; Lk. 3:16-17)

- One vet to come. One no one wants.
- Eternal punishment in hell. II Thess. 1:7-9 → in flaming fire...Luke 16:24 → I'm tormented in this flame
 - —Rev. 20:15 → whosoever was not found in the book of life was cast in the lake of fire
 - -Rev. 21:8 \rightarrow the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone which is the second death.
