

Three Things Gods Wants Us To Do Every Day In 2012

Psalm 90:7-12

I. God Wants Us To Seek His Word Every Day.

- To let Him talk to us every day. Not in some direct, audible, still small voice, dream, vision, etc., but through His word – The Bible.
- When we read, listen; learn the Bible, which is God speaking to us today. (Ps. 119:30; Eph. 3:4)
- The importance of daily Bible study. (Acts 17:11; Ps. 1:2; Matt. 4:4; Job. 23:12)
- What do we say about our love for God’s word by our attendance? (Acts 2:42)

The Psalmists taught the value of the word of God. (Ps. 19:7-11)

- **7** The law of the LORD *is* perfect, converting the soul;
The testimony of the LORD *is* sure, making wise the simple;
- 8** The statutes of the LORD *are* right, rejoicing the heart;
The commandment of the LORD *is* pure, enlightening the eyes;
- 9** The fear of the LORD *is* clean, enduring forever;
The judgments of the LORD *are* true *and* righteous altogether.
- 10** More to be desired *are they* than gold,
Yea, than much fine gold;
Sweeter also than honey and the honeycomb.
- 11** Moreover by them Your servant is warned,
And in keeping them *there is* great reward.

Plan to spend time with God’s word daily. (Matt. 6:33)

II. God Wants Us To Talk To Him Every Day

And He has blessed us with the ability to do that as we pray to Him.

- We need to talk to God daily. (Acts 2:42; Dan. 6:10; Ps. 5:3)
- The priority of prayer. (I Tim. 2:1-4)
 - We see in the earthly life of Jesus. (Lk. 18:1)
 - We see in the life of Paul. (I Thess. 5:17; Eph. 1:15ff; Phil. 1:3,4)
- Powerful passages promoting prayer:
 - Phil. 4:4-8
 - Col. 4:2-4
 - I Pet. 3:12

- God hears and answers prayer. (James 1:5-8)

III. God Wants Us To Talk To Others About Him Every Day.

- Our self -- as we meditate on God's word, and examine our lives by it. (Ps. 1:2; 119:15; II Cor. 13:5; Js. 1:23-25)
- Family – children, husband, wife...
 - Eph. 6:4; II Tim. 1:5
- Brethren – Mal. 4:16; Heb. 10:24-25
- The lost – Mk. 16:15; Acts 8:1-4; Jn. 15:1-6; Prov. 11:30
