Job 38:1-7

Introduction

•We all remember where we were when very significant events took place. Our lists may differ.

•All will remember where we were on the afternoon of April 27, 2011.

•During times of tragedy, loss, disaster, we focus more clearly on those things that are most important in life...put things into perspective.

•Lesson: A look at some of life's most precious things.

I. Life Itself...

•From God, The giver of life...(Gen. 2:7)

-Acts 17:25 \rightarrow 25 And he is not served by human hands, as if he needed anything. Rather, he himself gives everyone life and breath and everything else. (Ps. 139:14)

•What is your life? (Js. 4:14; Lk. 12:15)

–Brief.

• **47**Remember how short my time is: wherefore hast thou made all men in vain? **48**What man is he that liveth, and shall not see death? (Ps. 89:47-48)

•Job. 7:6; 9:25; 14:1-2

•Ps. 90:10,12 \rightarrow 10The days of our years are threescore years and ten; and if by reason of strength they be fourscore years, yet is their strength labour and sorrow; for it is soon cut off, and we fly away.

-Fragile.

•Ps. 39:4 \rightarrow 4 LORD, make me to know mine end, and the measure of my days, what it is: that I may know how frail I am.

•I Sam. 30:3 \rightarrow but truly as the LORD liveth, and as thy soul liveth, there is but a step between me and death.

•Eccl. 12:6-7 \rightarrow 6 before the silver cord is snapped, or the golden bowl is broken, or the pitcher is shattered at the fountain, or the wheel broken at the cistern, 7 and the dust returns to the earth as it was, and the spirit returns to God who gave it.

-Will end.

•Heb. 9:27 \rightarrow 27And just as it is appointed for man to die once, and after that comes judgment, (Eccl. 9:3-6; Jn. 9:4)

-Time to serve God and prepare for eternity.

•Acts 17:27 \rightarrow 27 that they should seek God, in the hope that they might feel their way toward him and find him.

•Ps. 90:12 \rightarrow 12 So teach us to number our days that we may get a heart of wisdom.

•Eccl. 12:13-14 \rightarrow 13 The end of the matter; all has been heard. Fear God and keep his commandments, for this is the whole duty of man. 14For God will bring every deed into judgment, with every secret thing, whether good or evil.

II. The Soul of Man

•In the image of our Creator.

-26 And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness... 27 So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them. (Gen. 1:26-27)

•It can be renewed while the outer man is decaying. II Cor. 4:16-18 \rightarrow 16 For which cause we faint not; but though our outward man perish, yet the inward man is renewed day by day.

Continues to live on when the body dies.

-Js. 2:26 \rightarrow 26 For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also.

-Lk. 16:22-24 \rightarrow 22 And it came to pass, that the beggar died, and was carried by the angels into Abraham's bosom: the rich man also died, and was buried; 23And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and Lazarus in his bosom. (cf. Lk. 23:42-43)

•In its resurrected body, has an eternal destiny.

-Rom. 2:7 \rightarrow 7 To them who by patient continuance in well doing seek for glory and honor and immortality, eternal life:

-Rom. 2:8-9 \rightarrow 8 But unto them that are contentious, and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness, indignation and wrath, 9 Tribulation and anguish, upon every soul of man that doeth evil...

•Nothing worthy of exchange.

-Matt. 16:26 \rightarrow 26 For what is a man profited, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul? or what shall a man give in exchange for his soul?

III. The Blood of Jesus Christ

•I Pet. 1:18-19 \rightarrow 18 Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers; 19 But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot:

•Nothing else will suffice. (Heb. 9:22; 10:4-5)

•The Blood of Jesus...

-Reconciles. (Eph. 2:13-19)

-Remits. (Matt. 26:28)

-Redeems. (Rev. 6:9)

- -Purchases. (Acts 20:28)
- -Propitiates. (Rom. 3:25)
- -Purges our conscience. (Heb. 9:14)
- -Washes away our sins. (Rev. 1:5; Acts 22:16)

IV. The Word of God

•I Sam. 3:1 \rightarrow 1 And the child Samuel ministered unto the LORD before Eli. And the word of the LORD was precious in those days; there was no open vision.

-Too many take the Bible for granted.

•Widely owned: little read, studied, respected.

•II Tim. 2:15; Rev. 1:3; Ps. 1:1-3

-Why the Word of God is precious:

•Inspired. (II Tim. 3:16-17)

•Words to live by. (Matt. 4:4)

•Given for our benefit. (I Tim. 4:8; Acts 20:32)

•The message of hope. (Rom. 10:17; Heb. 11:1)

•Standard of judgment. (Jn. 12:48)
