# Working In The Kingdom of God LK. 19:11-17

#### Introduction

•Jesus, the master teacher, and his use of parables. (Mk. 4:2,13; Matt. 13:10ff)

•One of less familiar parables  $\rightarrow$  Parable of the Pounds in Lk. 19.

•Some clear points of reference:

-The certain nobleman is Jesus Christ. (v-12)

-Going into a far country corresponds to his ascension back to heaven after his resurrection. (v-12)

-His servants are given duties and responsibilities. (v-13)

-The return is the second coming and judgment - a day of reckoning and accounting. (v-15)

•Three great lessons:

### I. The Kingdom of God

•Purpose for the parable. (Lk. 19:11)

•He went into a far country to receive for himself a kingdom. (Lk. 19:12)

-Jesus received the kingdom and began reigning as king when he ascended into heaven.

•Acts 2:30-36  $\rightarrow$  sit on my right hand until I make thy foes thy footstool.

•Heb. 1:13  $\rightarrow$  sit on my right hand until I make thy enemies thy footstool

•I Cor. 15:25  $\rightarrow$  for he must reign till he hath put all enemies under his feet. (cf. Zech. 6:13)

•He returned having received the kingdom. (Lk. 19:15; I Cor. 15::24)

-Not to set up an earthly kingdom in Jerusalem.

-The scriptures on the establishment of the kingdom: Dan. 2:44; Matt. 4:17; Mk. 9:1; Acts 8:12; Col. 1:13

-Many need to seek the kingdom of God now. (Jn. 3:3-5)

# II. Using Our Talents In The Kingdom of God

•Work to do in the kingdom of God. (I Cor. 15:58; Titus 2:14; v-13)

•Ability + Resources + Opportunity = Responsibility.

-Talents differ. Should grow and develop, not excuse.

-Each one is needed and necessary for the body to fully and properly function. (Rom. 12; Eph. 4:16; I Cor. 12:12-40)

•What can we do?

-Seek the lost. (Phil. 2:15-16; I Pet. 3:15); Restore the erring. (Js. 5:19-20; Gal. 6:1-2)

-Pray for one another. (Js. 5:16); Edify, encourage, admonish, be present. (Heb.

10:24-25); Comfort, aid the needy, weak, afflicted. (I Thess. 5:14; Js. 1:27)

-Serve in a physical capacity. (Acts 6)

•What resources do we have?

-Time. (24 hours/day; 168 hours/week - Eph. 5:16; Col. 4:5; Jn. 9:4)

-Degree of strength. (Phil. 4:13)

-Gospel. (Rom. 1:16; I Cor. 1:18; Rom. 10:17)
