John 14:1-3

- 1 Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me.
- 2 In my Father's house are many mansions: if *it* were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.
- 3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.

"I Will Come Again"

- He would be raised from the dead.
 - 16:16-20; Ps. 2:7; 16:10; Jn. 2:19-22; 20:8-9
- He would dwell in them and would be with them.
 - Jn. 14:18; 23; 15:1-7
- He would send the Holy Spirit to them, to equip them for the work for which He had taught and trained them.
 - 14:15-17, 26; Acts 1:8

The Work of the Holy Spirit In the Apostles

- The Holy Spirit would guide them into all truth.
 (Jn. 16:12-15; Jn. 8:32)
- The Holy Spirit would show them things to come. (I Thess. 4:13-18; II Pet. 3; Rev. 1:19)
- The Holy Spirit would convict the world of sin, righteousness and judgment. (Jn. 16:7-11)
- The Holy Spirit would enable them to bear witness of him. (15:26-27; 14:26)

"I Will Come Again"

- He would rise from the dead.
 - Ps. 2:7; 16:10; Jn. 2:19-22; 16:16-20; 20:8-9
- He would dwell in them and would be with them.
 - Jn. 14:18; 23; 15:1-7
- He would send the Holy Spirit to them, to equip them for the work for which He had taught and trained them.
 - 14:15-17; 26; Acts 1:8
- In the end of the world His second coming to receive them to glory. (14:3)

Importance of Each of These For Us

- Resurrection of Christ. (Rom. 1:3-4; Heb. 2:14-15; Rom. 4:25; I Cor. 5:20)
- Christ dwelling in us. (Eph. 3:17; Col. 1:27; Gal. 2:20; 3:26-27)
- The revelation of the Holy Spirit to the apostles. (Eph. 3:3-5; 5:17)
- His second coming. We have the blessed hope that He is coming again and has prepared a place for us. (I Thess. 4:18; I Jn. 3:2-3)
