Keys To Growth


• Seeking The Lost Without Respect of Persons.

- Recognizing that each person...
 - Created in God's image. (Gen. 1:26-28)
 - Descended from one man. (Acts 17:26)
 - Has common enemy and common problem. (Rom. 3:23; 6:23)
 - Same plan of redemption for all. (Jude 3; Mk. 16:15; Acts 15:11)
 - Facing the same judgment. (Jn. 12:48; II Cor. 5:10)
- God is no respecter of persons. (Rom. 2:11; Acts 10:34-35)
- The example of Jesus in John 3 and 4.
- The early church. Acts 8, 9, 10.

Keys To Growth

• Trusting in the power of the gospel.

- The message that must be taught. (Mk. 16:15)
- God's means of producing faith. (Rom. 10:17)
- Faith must be in God's power, not the wisdom of men. (I Cor. 2:1-5)
- The message is not only one of love, but one that is confrontational. (Acts 2:36; 7:51-53; 17:23; 24:24-25)
- The message does not change to draw the crowds or please the lost.
